¹ The chickenpox vaccine is offered to students in grade 6 who did not receive 2 doses when they were younger. It is not necessary for those who had chickenpox or shingles disease, diagnosed by a healthcare provider, at 1 year of age or older to get the vaccine.

² Children who were not previously immunized or did not complete their infant hepatitis B vaccine series will be offered hepatitis B vaccine for free in grade 6.

³ The HPV vaccine is provided free to girls and boys in grade 6 as a series of 2 doses given 6 months apart. The vaccine is being offered to boys in grade 6 for the first time starting in September 2017.
